No other vendor submitted a bid for <u>PA state</u> approved stone. Lopke has recently implemented a fuel escalation surcharge for all aggregate deliveries. The surcharge is based on the Dept. of Energy (PADD 1B – Central Atlantic) weekly gasoline and diesel fuel retail prices. The rate will increase or decrease 1% for every \$.10 increase or decrease above the base price of \$3.80 per gallon of diesel fuel. The material costs will be paid out of the State Liquid Fuels funds and any surcharge for deliveries will be paid out of the township's General Fund.

L&D Stone submitted pricing for aggregates, but their material is not PennDot approved and would have to be paid with monies from the General Fund. They are the only suppliers of DSA (driving surface aggregate) material. They quoted a price of \$8.25 per ton F.O.B. and \$15.65 per ton delivered.
