MONTHLY BUSINESS MEETING

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors was held at the township meeting room, beginning at 7:30 p.m. Sup. Dovin called the meeting to order and led in the pledge of allegiance to the American flag. The roll was called and all three supervisors were present.

Presentation of minutes and treasurer’s report – A motion was made by Sup. Doolittle, seconded by Sup. Mordovancey and unanimously carried by the board to approve the minutes and treasurer’s report as presented.

Citizens Input on the Agenda – No one had any input to share.

Reports of the board, commissions and committees

Susquehanna Co. Council of Governments, C.O.G. Sewage and Codes Committees –

Sup. Dovin said that a meeting was not held last month.

Report of Susquehanna Co. Planning Commission Meeting – A meeting was not held in June.

Report of Supervisors on Current Roadwork – Roads have been repaired, holes in the road have been patched/filled. The supervisors are three quarters of the way through repairs on the dirt roads.

OLD BUSINESS

Junkyard Ordinance Violations

The supervisors will call the PA Dept. of Environmental Protection regarding the violators and will document their conversations with D.E.P. The supervisors will verify the infractions and will then notify the secretary to send out letters to the parties involved.

NEW BUSINESS

Hawley Subdivision

A motion was made by Sup. Doolittle, seconded by Sup. Mordovancey and unanimously carried by the board to approve the subdivision without exceptions.

Horne Property – near Carmalt Rd. Bridge

A complaint was made by John Brownlow that the boulders that were put on Choconut Property should be moved so that parents can park their cars there when children are picked up by the bus. The supervisors discussed the situation with John and said that they had tried to have the school bus pull down on Pamela Drive but the school district did not want to move the stop.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION –

Don Randall said that when the supervisors use the stone rake on the roads, it needs to be pulled by a tractor, not a truck, so that the stones do not go into the ditch and the roads become full of “ripples”. The supervisors discussed the situation with Don.
