MONTHLY BUSINESS MEETING

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors was held at the township meeting room, beginning at 7:30 p.m. Sup. Dovin called the meeting to order and led in the pledge of allegiance to the American flag. The roll was called and all three supervisors were present.

Attendees at the Meeting –Gary T. Wilcox, John and Judy Ramsay.

Presentation of minutes and treasurer's report – A motion was made by Sup. Dovin, seconded by Sup. Doolittle and unanimously carried by the board to accept the minutes and the treasurer's report as submitted.

Citizens Input on the Agenda – No one had any input to share.

Reports of the board, commissions and committees

Susquehanna Co. Council of Governments, C.O.G. Sewage and Codes Committees –

Sup. Dovin reported that a meeting was not held due to the lack of a quorum. There were no concerns pertaining to Choconut.

Report of Susquehanna Co. Planning Commission Meeting – Meetings were held in May and June, but nothing pertaining to Choconut was discussed. Susquehanna County 911 needs to put up an additional tower.

Report of Supervisors on Current Roadwork – A lot of road repair work was completed. FEMA inspected the repair work that was done due to Hurricane Debbie which occurred last August. The request for reimbursement from FEMA was approved by them. The supervisors and the secretary-treasurer have been preparing the detailed paperwork that is necessary to receive a reimbursement from FEMA and have been submitting it to the FEMA project manager. A request will be submitted to FEMA for repairs to be made to the Carmalt Road bridge. Sup. Dovin has been working with engineers and PennDot to determine the proper repairs to be made and when the information has been received as to the cost of the repairs, it will be submitted to our FEMA project manager.

OLD BUSINESS

Violators of the junkyard ordinance

The supervisors signed letters to Dennis W. Hayes, Ted Parks and the owner of the Virginia Romanick property citing their violations and requesting that they take action within 30 days after the receipt of the letter to contact the supervisors, outlining the steps that they will be taking to correct the violation. Failure to respond to the letter will result in legal action being taken by the board of supervisors. The letters will be sent out via certified mail, return receipt requested.

NEW BUSINESS – Resolution 2025-07-07A for the destruction of old documents. Following a schedule set forth by the PA Historical Commission, a motion was made by Sup. Doolittle, seconded by Sup. Mordovancey and unanimously carried by the board to adopt the resolution.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION – No one had any comments to make at this point in the meeting.
