**MONTHLY BUSINESS MEETING**

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors was held at the township meeting room, beginning at 7:30 p.m. Sup. Dovin called the meeting to order and led in the pledge of allegiance to the American flag. The roll was called and all three supervisors were present.

**Presentation of minutes and treasurer’s report** – A motion was made by Sup. Doolittle, seconded by Sup. Mordovancey and unanimously carried by the board to accept the minutes and the treasurer’s report as submitted.

**Citizens Input on the Agenda** – No one had any input to share.

**Reports of the board, commissions and committees**

**Susquehanna Co. Council of Governments, C.O.G. Sewage and Codes Committees** –

Sup. Dovin reported that a meeting was held. The 5.4-acre lot of land owned by the C.O.G. was sold for \$7,900.00. There were no concerns pertaining to Choconut that were brought up for discussion.

**Report of Susquehanna Co. Planning Commission Meeting** – A meeting was not held; it was cancelled.

**Report of Supervisors on Current Roadwork** – A lot of road repair work was completed. A claim of \$172,000.00 was submitted by our FEMA project manager for damage sustained in Hurricane Debbie last August. Additional work needs to be done on Foolish Pleasure Road and repairs must be made to the Carmalt Rd. Bridge. Sup. Dovin explained in detail the repair work that must be done on the bridge and also stated that the supervisors plan to do some rip-rap installation on Hurley Brook where it runs along side Carmalt Rd. The plan includes re-routing Hurley Brook where it empties into the Choconut Creek.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**Violators of the junkyard ordinance**

Notices were sent out via certified mail with a return receipt required for several violators of the ordinance. The violators have 30 days following the receipt of the notice to respond to the supervisors. Failure to respond within that time period will result in further action to be taken by the supervisors.

**NEW BUSINESS** - No items of new business were brought up for discussion.

**PUBLIC PARTICIPATION** – A question of whether or not Kellam Road is a township road. The supervisors responded that it is. The question was raised as to why a traffic counter had been placed across the road. The supervisors responded that PennDot is planning on redoing the bridge on Kellam Road, because they own the bridge.

A motion was made by Sup. Doolittle and seconded by Sup. Mordovancey to approve the bill list, current bills and payroll.
